**BRAD PLUNKETT HONORED AT  
BUTLER UNIVERSITY ALUMNI RECOGNITION DINNER**

INDIANAPOLIS – Brad Plunkett, a 1992 Butler University alumnus, will receive the Hilton Ultimus Brown Alumni Achievement Award at the university's Alumni Recognition Dinner on Saturday, April 21 at 6 p.m. in the Atherton Union Reilly Room on campus.

The award will honor Plunkett for his personal and professional accomplishments as an alumnus of fewer than 15 years. With a pharmacy B.S. from Butler, Plunkett has worked as a pharmacist since graduation, serving in HIV/AIDS awareness and treatment.

In 1998, he earned certification as an HIV pharmacist at the University of Missouri. As key marketing specialist at Indianapolis' Statscript Pharmacy, Plunkett specializes in treating people with HIV and AIDS. A director-at-large for the Association of Nurses in AIDS Care, Plunkett collaborates with social service agencies to help clients obtain financial, emotional and medical assistance.

He served on the advisory board for the Midwest AIDS Training & Education Center as well as the Indiana State Department of Health HIV/AIDS Advisory Board and participates in events, such as the Indiana AIDS Walk and Festival and the annual Garage Party.

Plunkett also brought his service back to the university, acting as a co-instructor and intern preceptor for the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences.
