In an effort to establish Indiana as a nationally recognized high-technology region, Jones assumed leadership roles in several technology organizations, including the Indiana Technology Partnership, TechNet Indiana and GrowIndiana Media Ventures.

Jones also is involved with the boards of Art Technology Group, First Internet Bank and WebAssured.com, as well as community organizations, such as the Indianapolis Zoo, the Children's Museum and the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra.
